This event is in partnership with the Drug Enforcement Agency (DEA) and will occur between the hours of 10:00 AM and 2:00 PM. This program will provide an opportunity for members of our community to drop off their expired, unused, and unwanted pills free of charge, with no questions asked. The collected drugs will be destroyed.

This Drug Take-Back event provides our residents a safe way to dispose of their unwanted medication. WPD and the DEA encourage community members to take this opportunity and participate in this event. The DEA has provided two collection boxes and educational material which will be in the parking lot of the Westminster Civic Center located at 8200 Westminster Blvd., in the City of Westminster.
