OWNER - BUILDER DECLARATION

I hereby affirm under penalty of perjury that I am exempt from the Contractors' State License Law for the following reason (Section 7031.5 of the Business and Professions Code): Any city or county that requires a permit to construct, alter, improve, demolish, or repair any structure, prior to its issuance, shall require the applicant for the permit to file a signed statement that he or she is licensed pursuant to the provisions of the Contractors' State License Law (Chapter 9 of the Business and Professions Code) or that he or she is exempt therefrom and the commencing with Section 7000) of Division 3 of the Business and Professions Code) or that he or she is exempt therefrom and the commencing with Section 7031.5 by any applicant for a permit subjects the applicant to a civil penalty of not more than five hundred dollars (\$500).):

The contractor shall conform to the requirements of the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit for Construction Activities, NPDES No. CAS000002, and City of Westminster Ordinance No. 2231 in compliance with the Federal Requirements for the Control of Urban Stormwater Runoff. The contractor shall protect, in any means, all construction related materials from being transported from the site by stormwater runoff. The contractor and/or any subcontractors are required to place gravel bags and fabric around all storm drain inlets, and also place gravel bags around any storm drain as directed by the City Engineer, to protect polluted water from running into the storm drain systems.
