City postpones reopening of select facilities and Orange County issues amended health order to include hair salons and places of worship

WESTMINSTER, Calif. - The City of Westminster has postponed the reopening of City Hall, Police Department, and Community Services until June 8 to ensure procedures and safety measures are in place in accordance with county [orders](#).

Pursuant to the Orange County Health Officer's order issued May 23, all businesses that are permitted to reopen in Orange County, including city offices, must comply with [industry-specific guidelines](#) and post a checklist. An amended order issued May 28 reaffirms these mandates and also allows the reopening of hair salons/barbershops, church services, funerals, and cultural services.

City Hall and Community Services and Recreation will open Monday through Thursday from 8 a.m. to noon for walk-in visits, and 1 to 5 p.m. by appointment only. To ensure staff availability and reduce wait times, appointments are advised for the following services:

- Planning Division and Business Licenses - (714) 548-3247
- Building Division - (714) 548-3254
- Engineering Division - (714) 548-3243
- Community Services and Recreation - (714) 895-2860

The Police Department lobby will open Monday through Thursday from 8 a.m. to noon for walk-in visits. From 1 to 5 p.m. or for after-hour access to the Police Department, visitors can use the intercom system located to the left of the front doors. To contact the Police Department front desk for non-emergency inquiries, call (714) 898-3315.

For the safety of employees and visitors at city facilities, visitors will be required to wear face coverings prior to entering the building or receiving services, unless under the age of 2 or

certain conditions apply that prevent wearing a face covering. A limited number of cloth face coverings will be available at open city facilities for anyone who does not have one.

The Senior Center, Family Resource Center, and park facilities remain closed to the public until further notice.
