State issues mandate to close additional businesses, including hair and nail salons and malls

WESTMINSTER, Calif. - The State of California has announced a mandate to close indoor operations for the following business sectors, effective immediately and for at least three weeks:

- Fitness centers
- Worship services
- Protests
- Offices for non-essential sectors
- Personal care services, including nail salons, body waxing, and tattoo parlors
- Hair salons and barbershops
- Malls

The closures are in response to an increase in cases based on [county data](#) tracked and monitored by the state's public health officer.

The modification of operations in business sectors is part of the State of California's "[Resilience Roadmap](#)," aimed at eventually lifting the stay-at-home order currently in place.
