State issues mandate to close additional businesses, including hair and nail salons and malls

WESTMINSTER, Calif. - The State of California has announced a mandate to close indoor operations for the following business sectors, effective immediately and for at least three weeks:

- Fitness centers
- Worship services
- Protests
- Offices for non-essential sectors
- Personal care services, including nail salons, body waxing, and tattoo parlors
- Hair salons and barbershops
- Malls

The closures are in response to an increase in cases based on <u>county data</u> tracked and monitored by the state's public health officer.

The modification of operations in business sectors is part of the State of California's "Resilience Roadmap," aimed at eventually lifting the stay-at-home order currently in place.
