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### **Orange County moves back to purple tier, businesses to modify operations**

WESTMINSTER, Calif. - Orange County has moved from the red “substantial” tier to the purple “widespread” tier in the State of California’s “Blueprint for a Safer Economy” reopening plan. The purple tier is the most restrictive tier in the state’s color-coded, four-tier system aimed at gradually reopening business sectors safely.

Within 24 hours of the state’s announcement made today at noon, the following businesses, including those in Westminster, must modify operations to comply with the purple tier restrictions:

- **Restaurants**
  - May open outdoor only with modifications
- **Places of Worship**
  - May open outdoor only with modifications
- **Shopping Centers**
  - Indoor capacity must be limited to 25 percent for shopping malls, destination shopping centers, and swap meets
  - Closed common areas
  - Closed food courts
- **Retail**
  - Retail capacity must be limited to 25 percent
  - Grocery store capacity may remain limited to 50 percent
- **Hair Salons and Barbershops**
  - May reopen indoors with modifications

- **Personal Care Services** (e.g. nail salons, body waxing, tattoo parlors, piercing studios, skin care and cosmetology, massage services)
  - May reopen indoors with modifications
  
- **Gyms and Fitness Facilities**
  - May open outdoor only with modifications
  
- **Movie Theaters**
  - May open outdoor only with modifications

The City of Westminster will continue monitoring County of Orange Health Care Agency for local updates and will provide those when they become available.

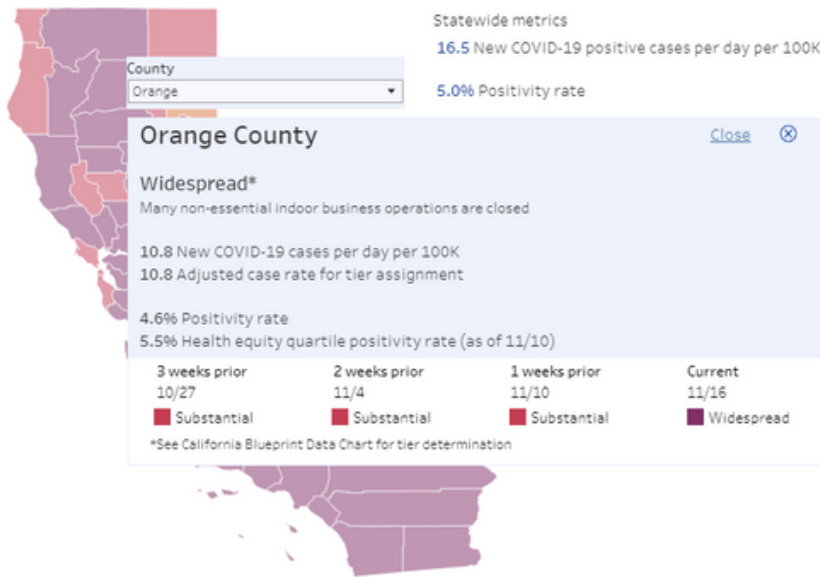
For information regarding schools, contact your local school district.
