VI. PUBLIC HEARINGS

AFTER THE PUBLIC HEARING IS OPENED, PERSONS SPEAKING IN FAVOR WILL BE HEARD FIRST, FOLLOWED BY THOSE PERSONS SPEAKING IN OPPOSITION; AND THEN PERSONS SPEAKING IN REBUTTAL. ONLY THOSE PERSONS WHO HAVE SPOKEN IN FAVOR WILL BE PERMITTED TO SPEAK IN REBUTTAL. SPOKESPERSON(S) DESIGNATED TO SPEAK IN FAVOR OR IN OPPOSITION WILL HAVE A TOTAL OF TWELVE (12) MINUTES TO SPEAK. THEREAFTER, EACH PERSON SPEAKING IN FAVOR OR IN OPPOSITION WILL HAVE THREE (3) MINUTES. THE TOTAL TIME FOR SPEAKING IN FAVOR OR IN OPPOSITION SHALL NOT EXCEED 30 MINUTES. THOSE PERSONS SPEAKING IN REBUTTAL WILL HAVE THREE MINUTES EACH, OR A TOTAL OF 20 MINUTES. THE PLANNING COMMISSION MAY USE ITS DISCRETION TO ALLOW A SPEAKER TO EXCEED TIME LIMITS.

A. <u>Case 2008-75 Site Plan, Tentative Parcel Map, and Variance</u>
Location: 14072-14074 Ash Street (Assessor's Parcel Number 195-243-01)

An application filed for a site plan and tentative parcel map involving the conversion of two existing rental units (completed in April of 2008) to condominiums. Although no physical changes to the existing dwelling units or site layout are proposed, a variance is also required from the minimum distance between dwelling units on the same lot because the development does not currently conform to such standard.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION: That the Planning Commission approve the Site Plan, Tentative Parcel Map, and Variance.

B. <u>Case 2008-91 Conditional Use Permit</u>
<u>Location: 8900 Westminster Boulevard (Assessor's Parcel Number 097-311-08) (My Thuan Market)</u>

An application filed for an amendment to an existing Conditional Use Permit to authorize the off-sale of beer, wine, and distilled spirits in conjunction with an established grocery market.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION: That the Planning Commission approve the Conditional Use Permit.

C. <u>Case 2009-10 Conditional Use Permit</u> <u>Location: 9743 Bolsa Avenue (Assessor's Parcel Number 098-453-13) (Le</u> Royal Restaurant)

An application filed for a Conditional Use Permit to allow the issuance of a California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) Type 47 License for on-sale and consumption of distilled spirits in conjunction with an established 5,315-square foot banquet facility/restaurant.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION: That the Planning Commission approve the Conditional Use Permit.

B. Case 2008-85 Design Review

<u>Location: 5082 Westminster Boulevard (Assessor's Parcel Number 195-410-03)</u>

An application for a Design Review, for the construction of a roof-mounted wireless communication facility to be screened within two faux chimneys.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION: That the Planning Commission approve the design as conditioned.

C. Case 2009-06 Design Review

<u>Location: 14501 Magnolia Street (Assessor's Parcel Numbers 097-341-01 and 097-341-02)</u>

Design Review to construct a 23-foot high pylon sign, with 96 square feet of sign area on a 1.92 acre site, developed with a 21,840 square foot single-story medical office building located at the southwest corner of Magnolia Street and Hazard Avenue.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION: That the Planning Commission determine a monument sign is appropriate for the site instead of the proposed 23-foot high pylon sign.
