8. PUBLIC HEARINGS

WHEN YOUR NAME IS CALLED, PLEASE STEP TO THE PODIUM AT THAT TIME AND STATE YOUR NAME AND ADDRESS FOR THE RECORD.

AFTER THE PUBLIC HEARING IS OPENED, PERSONS SPEAKING IN FAVOR WILL BE HEARD FIRST, FOLLOWED BY THOSE PERSONS SPEAKING IN OPPOSITION; AND THEN PERSONS SPEAKING IN REBUTTAL. ONLY THOSE

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PERSONS WHO HAVE SPOKEN IN FAVOR WILL BE PERMITTED TO SPEAK IN REBUTTAL. SPOKESPERSON(S) DESIGNATED TO SPEAK IN FAVOR OR IN OPPOSITION WILL HAVE TWELVE (12) MINUTES TO SPEAK. THEREAFTER, EACH PERSON SPEAKING IN FAVOR OR IN OPPOSITION WILL HAVE THREE (3) MINUTES. THE TOTAL TIME FOR SPEAKING IN FAVOR OR IN OPPOSITION SHALL NOT EXCEED 30 MINUTES. THOSE PERSONS SPEAKING IN REBUTTAL WILL HAVE THREE (3) MINUTES EACH, OR A TOTAL OF 20 MINUTES. THE PLANNING COMMISSION MAY USE ITS DISCRETION TO ALLOW A SPEAKER TO EXCEED THE TIME LIMITS.

**8.1 Case 2010-43 Review of existing Conditional Use Permit
Location: 15380 Beach Blvd (Assessor's Parcel Number 107-161-04)**

Consideration of extending the hours of operation and an evaluation of compliance with the conditions of approval specified in a conditional use permit granted to an existing restaurant/nightclub offering the on-site sale of alcoholic beverages and entertainment.

An application to demolish an existing 2,700 square-foot Popeye's restaurant and construct a new 3,752 square-foot, one-story, Chick-fil-A restaurant. Three variances are requested in association with the proposed development: a reduced front yard building setback, a reduced front yard canopy setback, and a reduced drive through aisle width.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends that the Planning Commission approve the development review and variances subject to recommended conditions of approval.
