Public Hearing A. Case 2006-71 Tentative Parcel Map, Site Plan, and Design

Review

<u>Location: 13361 Edwards Street (Assessor's Parcel Number</u>

203-581-01)

An application to demolish an existing single-family dwelling and develop three condominium/townhouse units. Each unit is two

stories, approximately 25 feet high, and includes roughly 3,000 square feet of living area.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION: That the Planning Commission approve the tentative parcel map, site plan, and design review.

Mr. Chris Wong presented the facts and analysis of the proposed application to develop three condominium/townhouse units in the subject property. Based on these findings, Mr. Wong recommended that the Planning Commission approve the tentative parcel map, site plan, and design review subject to the conditions listed in the draft resolution.

The public hearing was opened and speaking in favor was the applicant/architect, Mr. Duc Nguyen of MVI Architects, 11770 E. Warner Avenue, Fountain Valley. He stated that the proposed development will benefit the community. He was available to answer any questions.

Speaking in opposition, Mr. Dale Bradberry of 6531 Tillamook, stated that his lives across the proposed project. He expressed his concern regarding the heavy traffic and lack of available parking along Edwards Street. He contended that the proposed condominium/townhouse project does not provide sufficient parking spaces for potential homeowners/tenants whom he expects to own two or three cars each unit.

In rebuttal, Mr. Nguyen explained that each unit will have two-car garages and two guests parking spaces per code requirement. He stated that he has been to the project site at different times and did not observe any parking problem along Edward Street.

The public hearing was closed.

Chairman Tran liked the project and design.

Commissioner Turro commented that the design is good, and since the project meets the City's parking standards, there was no other alternative but approve the project.

Commissioner Vo concurred with Chairman Tran and Commissioner Turro adding that no one knows for certain that each condominium/townhome unit would have two or more cars.

Motion

Based on staff findings and analysis, Commissioner Vo moved that the Planning Commission approve the tentative parcel map, site plan, and design review subject to the conditions listed in the draft resolution. Commissioner Ho seconded and the motion carried 4-0, Commissioner Bertels absent.
