Reports A. Case 2010-19 Zone Text Amendment Initiation Location: Citywide

Initiation of Zoning Text Amendment (ZTA) to authorize City staff to begin updating the City's sign regulations (Chapter 17.330 of the Westminster Municipal Code). The objectives of the ZTA is to make the sign code user friendly, clarifying/revising terms, addressing the non-conforming sign provisions, and establishing provisions for signs that are not addressed in the existing code.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION: That the Planning Commission adopt the Resolution initiating the Zone Text Amendment.

Mr. Art Bashmakian made a brief presentation and stated the reasons for amending the Sign Code. The goal is to make the Sign Code more user friendly.

Chairman Tran stated that the sign code is old and it is time to initiate a new code. He asked if it would be handled by the Planning department or would the Commission be involved in the process.

Mr. Bashmakian explained that once initiated, we would look into creating a committee depending on how much involvement the City wishes to have in the project. The committee might be a mix of Commission, Council, and Community. At a minimum there will be involvement from the business community.

There were no further questions from the Commissioners.

Motion

On motion of Commissioner Bertels, seconded by Commissioner Turro, and carried 4-0 (Commissioner Ho absent), the Planning Commission approved the Zone Text Amendment Initiation for Case Number 2010-19 Resolution Number 10-009.

B. <u>Case 2010-20 Zone Text Amendment Initiation</u> <u>Location: Citywide</u>

Initiation of Zoning Text Amendment (ZTA) to authorize City staff to update the zoning code by defining industrial, manufacturing and production uses. The intent of this ZTA is to clearly define and expand what businesses are included with industrial, manufacturing and production uses.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION: That the Planning Commission adopt the Resolution initiating the Zone Text Amendment.

Mr. Art Bashmakian made a brief presentation indicating that this is a minor item in terms of the work that is to be involved. This Zoning Text Amendment will define industrial, manufacturing and production uses to update definitions to the types of uses found in these businesses today. Parking and location will also be addressed, making it more comprehensively defined for these uses.

There were no questions from the Commissioners.

Motion

On motion of Commissioner Turro, seconded by Commissioner Vo, and carried 4-0 (Commissioner Ho absent), the Planning Commission approved the Zone Text Amendment Initiation for Case Number 2010-20 Resolution Number 10-010.

C. <u>Case 2010-21 Zone Text Amendment Initiation</u> <u>Location: Citywide</u>

Initiation of Zoning Text Amendment (ZTA) to authorize City staff to update the City's parking standard for places of worship and those uses proposed in conjunction with a place of worship (Chapter 17.320 of the Westminster Municipal Code). The purpose of the amendment will be to clarify the parking requirement for multiple uses proposed in conjunction with a place of worship such as offices, classrooms, sleeping quarters for members of the religious habit, multi-purpose rooms, etc.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION: That the Planning Commission adopt the Resolution initiating the Zone Text Amendment.

Mr. Art Bashmakian made a brief presentation indicating that the current parking standard only addresses the sanctuary in places of worship, but typically there are other activities at places of worship that are not addressed. This initiation will allow review other areas of church use and address the parking requirements associated with those uses.

There were no questions from the Commissioners.

Motion

On motion of Commissioner Vo, seconded by Commissioner Turro, and carried 4-0 (Commissioner Ho absent), the Planning Commission approved the Zone Text Amendment Initiation for Case Number 2010-21 Resolution Number 10-011.
