A longtime community leader, Rice was first elected to the city council in November 1994 where she served two full terms as a council member. In 2000, Rice was elected as mayor and served as mayor through 2012. She continued her service as a council member until her retirement from the city council in 2018.

As an avid supporter of the arts, Rice developed and advocated for a performing arts center in Westminster, which resulted in the construction of the city's Rose Center Theater.

Prior to her service on the city council, Rice served as a member of the Westminster School District Board of Trustees for over 17 years. Rice also joined the Midway City Sanitary District Board in 1990 where she actively served until her passing.

Born on January 9, 1929, Rice moved to Westminster in 1956 and was a resident for 65 years.
