

NOTICE OF VACANCY PLANNING COMMISSION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Westminster City Council is now accepting applications for one unscheduled vacancy on the Planning Commission for a term expiring November 2022.

The Planning Commission shall have the power to adopt rules for the transaction of its business, subject to approval of the City Council, and such power and duties as are or may hereafter be specified by state law or resolution of the City Council in the following areas: area variances, conditional use permits, site plans, parcel maps, environmental impact reports and negative declarations, and zone changes.

Each member of the commission shall receive the sum of eighty dollars for each attendance at a regular or adjourned regular meeting of the planning commission; provided, that compensation shall not exceed thirty-six meetings per year.

Applicants must be residents of the City of Westminster and must provide the following documents to be considered:

- A completed application
- Signed Code of Ethics
- A copy of a utility bill or other bill with applicant's name and address*
- A copy of a driver's license or state-issued identification card*

Completed applications should be submitted to the City Clerk's office by **5:30 p.m.** on Thursday, September **30**, **2021** for consideration at the October 13, 2021 City Council meeting. Late applications may be considered at the Council's discretion.
