



## NOTICE OF VACANCY MONUMENTS AND MEMORIALS COMMITTEE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Westminster City Council is accepting applications for 9 vacancies on the Monuments and Memorials Committee.

The purpose of the Monuments and Memorials Committee is to review all requests from private groups or individuals for proposed monuments, plaques, donor tiles, structures, markers, any other memorial, and modifications to existing monuments on any city property. The committee is advisory to the City Council and consists of:

- 5 members, with each council member appointing a single representative;
- 1 at-large member from the Vietnam War Memorial in Westminster, Inc.;
- 1 at-large member from the Coalition of the Republic of Vietnam Veterans Association;
- 1 at-large member from the Vietnam Veterans of America (preference to local chapter); and
- 1 at-large member from the Tập Thể Chiến Sĩ VNCH. Trung Tâm Tây Nam Hoa Kỳ.

Applicants must be Westminster residents and must provide the following documents to be considered:

- A completed application
- Signed Code of Ethics
- A copy of a utility bill or other bill with applicant's name and address\*
- A copy of a driver's license or state-issued identification card\*

Completed applications should be submitted to the City Clerk's office by **5:30 p.m. on Monday, October 4, 2021** for consideration at the October 13, 2021 City Council meeting. Late applications may be considered at the Council's discretion.
