REDISTRICTING OF CITY COUNCIL DISTRICTS**

Pursuant to California Elections Code Section 21607.1, NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WESTMINSTER WILL HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING at its meeting of November 10, 2021 at 8 p.m., at which time the City Council will 1) receive a report on the redistricting process and permissible criteria to be considered to redraw City Council election district boundaries; and 2) conduct a public hearing to receive public input on the redistricting process and permissible criteria (including without limitation district boundaries and composition thereof).

Resulting from suspension of certain provisions of the Ralph M.
