Possible Hit and Run Traffic Collision - UPDATE

WESTMINSTER, Calif. – On Monday, January 3, 2022, at approximately 0522 hours, officers from the Westminster Police Department responded to the 6500 block of Walt Street in the City of Westminster regarding a possible fatal hit and run traffic collision.

Upon arrival, officers located a deceased male in the driveway of a residence who had been struck by a vehicle. The vehicle fled the area prior to officers' arrival. Investigation has revealed the subject was intentionally struck by the vehicle deeming it a homicide. The victim's identity is not being revealed at this time pending notification of next of kin.

Detectives are currently looking for an older model gray or black Jeep Grand Cherokee with custom chrome wheels and a roof rack. The driver's side headlight housing was recovered at the scene and is missing from the vehicle. There is possible extensive damage to the front and rear passenger side and a broken taillight.
