### Proposed HOME-ARP Allocation Plan

Administration and Planning (15% maximum)	\$241,966
<ul> <li>Affordable Rental Housing</li> <li>Tenant-Based Rental Assistance (TBRA)</li> <li>Supportive Services</li> <li>Acquisition and Development of Non-Congregate Shelter</li> </ul>	\$1,371,141
Total HOME-ARP Allocation	\$1,613,107

\*Activities to be funded and funding amount will depend on consultation with agencies and service providers and needs assessment

### **Other Efforts**

#### **City efforts to support qualifying populations**

Homeless Outreach Team to address needs of homeless (WPD, CityNet and Community-Based Coalition)

Westminster Family Resource Center provides supportive services to low-income and at-risk households

Tenant-Based Rental Assistance Program to assist individuals and families at risk of homelessness

### Other Efforts Continued...

#### **Affordable Rental Housing**

Della Rosa – 50 units (25 PSH units) completed in Summer 2020

Westminster Crossing – 65 units (20 PSH units) completed in Fall 2021
