Citizens Oversight Committee (Measure SS)

The Citizens Oversight Committee reviews the City's budgeting and accounting practices with regards to the receipt and expenditure of the fiscal year's one cent (1%) transactions and use (sales) tax generated by the passage of Measure SS, the Essential Services ballot measure.

Commission on Aging

The Commission on Aging works to identify the needs of Westminster Seniors within the City and to create a citizen awareness of these needs; to encourage improved standards of services to Westminster Seniors and to encourage establishment of needed new services for seniors, both public and private; to encourage coordination among organizations providing services to seniors within the City and Orange County, and to provide advice and assistance where appropriate; and to advise the City Council on all matters affecting senior services within the City.

Cultural Arts Commission

The Cultural Arts Commission is advisory to the City Council. The Commission makes recommendations on policies pertaining to arts programs, cultural affairs, the Cultural Arts Center and fund development. Interpret the cultural needs of the community and stimulate community interest in cultural arts (visual and performing).

Personnel Board

The Personnel Board shall hold hearings and make recommendations on any matter pertaining to personnel administration within the limits of the request. The Personnel Board shall hear written appeals from disciplinary actions, dismissal, demotion, suspension or alleged violation of the rules and regulations, including but not limited to the rules set forth in the City's Personnel Manual adopted by Resolution No. 2566 and any amendments thereto, when such appeal is made by any person in the classified service, and shall certify its findings and recommendations to the City Manager and the City Council.

Quang Tri Monument Committee

The purpose of the Quang Tri Monument Committee is to evaluate and make recommendations regarding the overall design, how to best depict the images and messages, which units to honor, and the title for the monument; but not determine the location for the monument. The 11-member committee is advisory to the City Council.

Traffic Commission

The Traffic Commission reviews and studies all traffic matters within the city and make recommendations to the City Council. Some of these matters include minor street striping; traffic, except regulatory signs; and crosswalk designation.

Each member of a commission *may* receive a stipend for each attendance at a regular or adjourned regular meeting, provided that compensation does not exceed a certain number of meetings per year, which may vary by commission.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Each member may be required to file Fair Political Practices Commission Form, Statement of Economic Interest (SEI – Form 700).
