**Purpose of This Meeting**

The South Coast Air Quality Management District (South Coast AQMD) has scheduled a Public Workshop on Proposed Amended Rule 1148.2 – Notification and Reporting Requirements for Oil and Gas Wells and Chemical Suppliers (PAR 1148.2) to solicit information and suggestions from the public. PAR 1148.2 is scheduled to be considered for adoption at a Public Hearing before the South Coast AQMD Governing Board on November 4, 2022 (subject to change).

**Proposed Amended Rule 1148.2 Background**

Rule 1148.2 was developed to gather air quality information related to oil and gas well drilling, well completion, and well reworks. Over the past several years, South Coast AQMD staff has worked collaboratively with community members to identify air quality issues and develop Community Emission Reduction Plans (CERPs) for certain environmental justice communities. The Wilmington, Carson, West Long Beach CERP and the South Los Angeles draft CERP include a control action to initiate rule amendments to 1148.2 to enhance notifications and reporting. PAR 1148.2 is being amended to implement the control action and proposes measures to require notifications for injection well and workover rig operations, and annual reports of chemicals used at well sites.

**Proposed Amended Rule 1148.2 Objectives**

PAR 1148.2 will implement control actions contained in the Wilmington, Carson, West Long Beach CERP and the South Los Angeles draft CERP. PAR 1148.2 applies to operators of oil and gas wells and chemical suppliers. PAR 1148.2 includes new notification requirements for acidizing of injection wells and workover rig operations, will set notification requirements in relation to distances between a well and sensitive receptor(s), will remove outdated reporting requirements, and will require annual reporting to track chemicals used at well sites.

**California Environmental Quality Act**

Pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and South Coast AQMD's certified regulatory program (Public Resources Code Section 21080.5, CEQA Guidelines Section 15251(l) and South Coast AQMD Rule 110), the South Coast AQMD, as lead agency, is currently

reviewing the proposed project (PAR 1148.2) to determine if it will result in any potential adverse environmental impacts. Appropriate CEQA documentation will be prepared based on the analysis.
