

POLICE RESERVE OFFICER (Part-time)

Definition

Serves to augment regular police services in a variety of areas including patrol, traffic, investigation, identification, and special events.

Duties and Responsibilities

Works with field officers to receive training; assist with stake-outs and follow-up investigations; assists with traffic control and accident investigation; assist with evidence maintenance and disposition and property maintenance; augments police personnel in times of emergency; assist with crowd control for special events; performs routine patrol functions.

Qualifications

Skills in:

- speaking effectively with a wide variety of people;
- exercising good judgment and self-control;
- communicating in English, both orally and in writing.

Physical

Must be a minimum of 21 years of age.

Education

- High school graduate or equivalent.
- Must complete basic reserve course within one year of employment.
- Possession of valid California Driver's License, Class 3, is required.
- Successful completion of police background investigation and pre-hire physical is required.
