

## Proclamation

## NATIONAL VOTER REGISTRATION DAY

**September 19, 2023** 

WHEREAS, one of the most fundamental and sacred rights of any democracy is the right to vote; in order for our government to function effectively and respond to the needs of our people, citizens must play a role in shaping it; and

WHEREAS, National Voter Registration Day is a nonpartisan civic holiday celebrating our democracy and it was first observed in 2012; and

WHEREAS, each year on National Voter Registration Day, we reaffirm the strong sense of civic duty among our people and encourage friends, family members, and neighbors to get involved by registering to vote; and

WHEREAS, elections are of paramount importance, and the outcomes of these elections directly impact the residents of Westminster; when we do not take full advantage of the right to vote, we not only give away our voice, we also give away the ability to shape our community's future; and

WHEREAS, according to U.S. Census data from 2020, as many as 1 in 4 eligible Americans are not registered to vote; and

WHEREAS, on this day, National Voter Registration Day, we recommit to making our voices heard in the next election.

NOW, THEREFORE I, Chi Charlie Nguyen, Mayor of the City of Westminster, on behalf of Vice Mayor NamQuan Nguyen, and Council Members Amy Phan West, Carlos Manzo, and Kimberly Ho do hereby proclaim September 19, 2023, as NATIONAL VOTER REGISTRATION DAY in the City of Westminster and urge all citizens to observe this day by ensuring they are registered to vote.
