NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on October 25, 2023, the City Council of the City of Westminster duly passed and adopted an Ordinance entitled:

ORDINANCE NO. 2608

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WESTMINSTER, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING CHAPTER 2.62.050 (COMMISSION ON AGING – MEMBERSHIP), OF TITLE 2 (ADMINISTRATION AND PERSONNEL), OF THE WESTMINSTER MUNICIPAL CODE, TO UPDATE RULES GOVERNING CITY COMMISSIONS

The City Council of the City of Westminster HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

This ordinance amends Section 2.62.050 (Commission on Aging – Membership) of the Westminster Municipal Code, related to age of applicant. The following is the recommended change:

- Change the age requirement from sixty-two years of age to fifty-five years of age.

The City Council conducted introduction and first reading on October 11, 2023. The City Council at its Regular Meeting on October 25, 2023 conducted second reading, passed, and adopted Ordinance No. 2608, as listed above with the following roll call to wit:
