

Proclamation

COMMEMORATES THE 50TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE INVASION OF VIETNAM'S PARACEL ISLANDS

WHEREAS, the City of Westminster, California notes that Vietnam has exercised sovereignty over the Paracel Islands (Hoang Sa) since the 19th Century and occupied these islands until 1974; and

WHEREAS, the People's Republic of China (PRC) invaded the Paracels on January 19, 1974 with military force and in the ensuing battle 74 soldiers and sailors of the Republic of Vietnam gave their lives; and

WHEREAS, the PRC's seizure and continued occupation of the Paracels is a violation of the United Nations Charter, which prohibits the use of force and calls on all Members to respect the sovereignty, territorial integrity and political independence of other States; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. State Department has declared that the "PRC actions in asserting its expansive and unlawful South China Sea maritime claims undermine peace and security in the region."

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Chi Charlie Nguyen, Mayor of the City of Westminster, on behalf of Vice Mayor Kimberly Ho, and Council Members Amy Phan West, Carlos Manzo, and NamQuan Nguyen do hereby proclaim that the City of Westminster, California hereby commemorates the 50th anniversary of the invasion of Vietnam's Paracel Islands, honors all Vietnamese who have died or been harmed in defense of Vietnam's sovereignty, and calls on China to respect international laws and end its occupation of the Paracel Islands.
