

CITY OF WESTMINSTER PUBLIC NOTICE ORDINANCE SUMMARY

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on May 8, 2024, the City Council of the City of Westminster introduced an Ordinance entitled:

ORDINANCE NO. 2611

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WESTMINSTER, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING TITLE 2.04 (ADMINISTRATION AND PERSONNEL, CITY COUNCIL) OF THE **ADDING** WESTMINSTER MUNICIPAL CODE 2.04.135 (ELECTRONIC **FILING** OF CAMPAIGN **DISCLOSURE** INFORMATION) TO MANDATE ELECTRONIC AND PAPERLESS FILING OF CAMPAIGN FINANCE DISCLOSURE STATEMENTS BY ELECTED OFFICIALS, CANDIDATES, OR COMMITTEES

This ordinance will add Section 2.04.135 to the Westminster Municipal Code which would require the filing of Campaign Disclosure Statements and Statements of Economic Interest by elected officials, candidates, staff, consultants, or committee to be completed and filed electronically with the City Clerk, pursuant to California Government Code Section 84615. While the electronic filing of these statements will be mandated under this ordinance, the City Clerk, as the City's filing officer, will have the right to accept a paper filing in lieu of an electronic filing at the City Clerk's discretion, under certain circumstances, and to accommodate an Americans with Disability (ADA) request.

The City Clerk shall issue an electronic confirmation that notifies the filer that the Statement was received, and the notification shall include the date and the time that the Statement was received and the method by which the filer may view and print the data received by the City Clerk.

If the City's filing system is not capable of accepting a Statement due to technical difficulties or other valid reasons in the Clerk's discretion, then a Statement in paper format shall be filed with the City Clerk.

The City Council will conduct second reading and adopt at its Regular Meeting on May 22, 2024, scheduled to commence at 6:00 PM.

A certified copy of the complete text of the Ordinance is posted and may be read and reviewed at City Hall, City Clerk's Office, 8200 Westminster Boulevard, Westminster, CA 92683 and/or a copy may be obtained from the City Clerk at a nominal charge during posted business hours.
