Clearing and grubbing shall also include the removal and restoration of sprinkler heads and irrigation lines encountered during demolition and construction; and removal and disposal of the existing fencing on the project site's premise.

The Contractor shall remove tree roots, if encounter, as necessary for the purpose of making grades and compaction for new improvements as shown on the plans.

Once the SWPPP is approved and prior to start of construction, the City of Westminster, as the Legally Responsible Party (LRP), will file the Permit Registration Documents through the

Payment for Furnish and Install Construction Fencing with Windscreen (Bid Item 5) shall be made at the contract unit per lump sum price bid. Said payment shall include full compensation for furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment, 6-foot high fence with windscreen, and all other work required on the plans and in the specifications and no additional compensation will be allowed.

BID ITEMS 6, 8, and 28, 30 : <u>INSTALL PCC SIDEWALK, DRIVEWAY AND PCC CURB & GUTTER, CONCRETE HEADER 8" WIDE</u>

The construction of PCC sidewalk, driveway, curb and gutter, and concrete header 8" wide, shall conform to Section 201-1, 303-1, 303-5, and applicable subsections of the Greenbook Standard Specifications; the City of Westminster Standard Drawing no. 203 and 209; and Orange County Public Works Std. Plan No. 1803.

Installation of the PCC sidewalk, driveway, curb and gutter, concrete header 8" wide includes the removal of existing PCC concrete sections and shall conform to the plans, specifications, Standard Specifications, and the City of Westminster standards.

All existing PCC concrete sections that are to be joined to new construction shall be sawcut in a straight line. The Contractor shall exercise due to caution to avoid any damage to the existing improvements to be protected in place. Any damage done by contractor and/or his equipment shall be repaired or replaced as called out in Section 7-9 of the Standard Specifications at contractor's expense.

Removal of existing PCC concrete items, structure, and sections shall be done to the depth or length required for construction of the replacement sections as shown on the plans. It is the contractor's responsibility to do whatever subsurface exploration required to submit a complete bid covering the cost of removal to the grades required.

The Contractor shall also cut and remove any tree roots encountered within construction limits to at least one (1) foot below the subgrade. All removal materials become the property of the contractor and shall be hauled and disposed of properly outside of the roadway right-of-way.

Payment for Remove and Replace 4" Thick PCC Sidewalk (Bid Item 6) shall be at the contract unit price per square feet bid for each bid item. Said payment shall include full compensation for, but not be limited to, furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment, sawcutting, sidewalk, grading, setting forms, PCC placement, finishing, cleanup, removal, tree root trimming, hauling disposal, and all incidentals for doing all the work involved in the constructing PCC items and no additional compensation will be allowed.

Payment for Remove and Replace P.C.C. Driveway (Bid Item 8) shall be at the contract unit price per square feet bid for each bid item. Said payment shall include full compensation for, but not be limited to, furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment, sawcutting, sidewalk, grading, setting forms, PCC placement.

The contract unit price per linear foot for Install PCC Curb and Gutter (Bid Item 28), and Install Concrete Header 8" Wide (Bid Item 30), shall include full compensation for furnishing all labor, excavation, remove roots, disposal of existing materials, tools, equipment, forming, base material (CMB), and all other work necessary for the removal of existing and construction of curb and gutter, as shown on the plans, and no other compensation will be allowed

Payment for Install PCC Curb and Gutter (Bid Item 28), and Install Concrete Header 8" Wide (Bid Item 30), shall be at the contract unit price per linear foot bid for each bid item. Said payment shall include full compensation for, but not be limited to, furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment, sawcutting, grading, setting forms, PCC placement, finishing, cleanup, removal, tree root trimming, hauling disposal, and all incidentals for doing all the work involved in the constructing PCC items and no additional compensation will be allowed.

BID ITEM 7: FURNISH AND INSTALL DECOMPOSED GRANITE

Decomposed granite shall conform to Section 20-5.03D of the State Standard Specifications, these Special Provisions, and technical specifications in appendix b, section 32 15 40 – decomposed granite surfacing.

Compact subgrade to a relative compaction of 95 percent and apply preemergent weed control before placing the first layer of decomposed granite.

Measurement and Payment:

Payment for Decomposed Granite (Bid Item 7) shall be included in the unit price bid per square foot and shall include full compensation for furnishing all labor, material, tools, equipment, incidentals and for doing all work involved including subgrade preparation, application of preemergent weed control and solidifying emulsion, in constructing decomposed granite as shown on the plans, as specified in the State Standard Specifications, these Special Provisions, and specifications, and as directed by the Engineer.

ITEMS 9: REBUILD EXISTING LOW WALL/PONY WALL TO BE LEVELED WITH ADJACENT EXISTING WALL 36" HEIGHT MAX

The Contractor shall rebuild the existing low wall / pony wall to be leveled with the adjacent existing wall 36" height max.



- CONSTRUCTION SITES SHALL BE MAINTAINED IN SUCH A CONDITION THAT AN ANTICIPATED STORM DOES NOT CARRY WASTES AND POLLUTANTS OFF SITE.

 DISCHARGES OF MATERIAL OTHER THAN STORM WATER ARE ALLOWED ONLY WHEN NECESSARY FOR PERFORMANCE AND COMPLETION OF CONSTRUCTION PRACTICES AND WHERE THEY DO NOT: CAUSE OR CONTRIBUTE TO A VIOLATION OF ANY WATER QUALITY STANDARD; CAUSE OR THREATEN TO CAUSE POLLUTION, CONTAMINATION, NUISANCE; OR CONTAIN A HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCE IN A QUANTITY REPORTABLE UNDER FEDERAL REGULATIONS 40CFR PARTS 117 & 301. POTENTIAL POLLUTANTS INCLUDE BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO: SOLID OR LIQUID CHEMICAL SPILLS, WASTES FROM PAINTS, STAINS, SEALANTS, GLUES, LIMES, PESTICIDES, HERBICIDES, WOOD PRESERVATIVES AND SEALANTS; ASBESTOS FIBERS, PAINT FLAKES, OR STUCCO FRAGMENTS; FUEL OIL, LUBRICANTS AND HYDRAULIC, RADIATOR AND BATTER FLUIDS; FERTILIZERS, VEHICLE/EQUIPMENT STEAM CLEANING OR CHEMICAL DEGREASING; AND SUPERCHLORINATED POTABLE WATER LINE FLUSHING. DURING CONSTRUCTION, DISPOSAL OF SUCH MATERIALS SHOULD OCCUR IN A SPECIFIED AND CONTROLLED TEMPORARY AREA ON SITE, PHYSICALLY SEPARATED FROM POTENTIAL STORM WATER RUN-OFF, WITH ULTIMATE DISPOSAL IN ACCORDANCE WITH LOCAL, STATE, AND FEDERAL REQUIREMENTS.
- 2. DEWATERING OF CONTAMINATED GROUNDWATER, OR DISCHARGING CONTAMINATED SOILS VIA SURFACE EROSION IS PROHIBITED. DEWATERING OF NON-CONTAMINATED GROUNDWATER REQUIRES A NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM PERMIT FROM THE RESPECTIVE STATE REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD.
